Instructions for Authors

Papers must be submitted as text files in Microsoft Word format 2003/2007/2010/2013/2016.

The file name should contain abbreviated first names and surnames of authors.

Paper size: Standard A4 size; Margins: Top edge – 25 mm, Bottom edge – 32 mm; Right side – 25 mm; Left side – 25 mm. We highly recommend to follow **the template*** when

preparing materials.

Title: Style – "Title", Font size – 13pt, Bold, Capital, Alignment – Center, Indentation (none).

Authors: Style – "Authors", Line Spacing Single, size – 12pt, Alignment – Left, Indentation (none); Abbreviated First Name and Surname – in Bold; Affiliation – in Italics (Font Style - "Subtle Emphasis").

Abstract: Style – "Subtle Emphasis", Line Spacing Single, Font: size – 12pt, Italic, Indentation (First line) by 1.25 cm, Alignment – Justify, Maximum Length is 5 rows.

Body: Style – "Normal", Font size – 14pt, Spacing – multiple 1.1, Alignment – Justify, Indentation (First line) by 1.25 cm.

The Title, information about the Authors and the Abstract must be presented in the English and Russian languages. Materials must **not exceed 6 pages**, including figures and tables numbered consecutively.

Figures and Tables: Figure Captions, Table Headings, Tables and comments to them should be written in 13pt font, Line Spacing – multiple 1.0, Indentation (none), Alignment: for Table – Left, for Figure Captions – Center.

Formulas and Equations: Mathematical and Chemical Formulas (Style – "Formula") must be written in 14pt font, Line Spacing – multiple 1.1, Indentation (First line) by 1.25 cm, Tab Stop – 15.25 cm (for the formula number). It is recommended to use Microsoft Equation Editor for complex formulas, Roman font – for Greek symbols and numbers, Italics – for Latin letters.

References List should be performed in accordance with GOST 7.05-2008, placed at the end of the document, compiled in the order of mention and typed in 13pt font (Style – "Subtle Reference"), Line Spacing – 1.0, Indentation (First line) by 1.25 cm, numbered in square brackets: [1], [2], etc. The heading "References" (style – "Subtle Reference") is written in 13pt font, center aligned with none indentation.


